You will then upload a screenshot of your grades for the appropriate term (2 quarters) and submit a signed parent permission form that will allow the CSF officers to view your grades for verification purposes. Finally, please pay \$10 view the ASB webstore and submit payment verification. These fees go towards the costs of the gold cords, certificates, the banquet, and registration fees.
